## The Challenge

Prince George's County is a high profile communication center and provides tours to a variety of politicians, government officials, and other visitors on a regular basis.

The customer had a unique vision and wanted to design a new emergency dispatch center and supporting infrastructure as a model of excellence. Deadlines were tight on the build because management wanted to officially open the center prior to a change in government.
